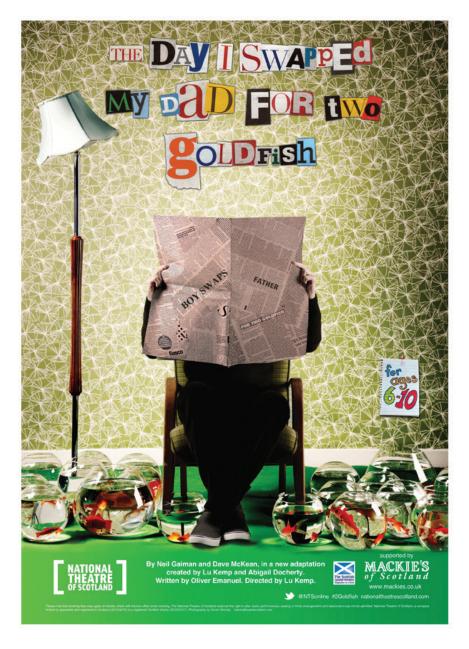


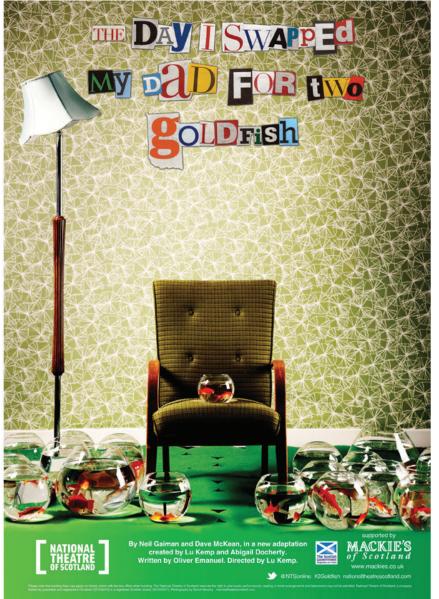

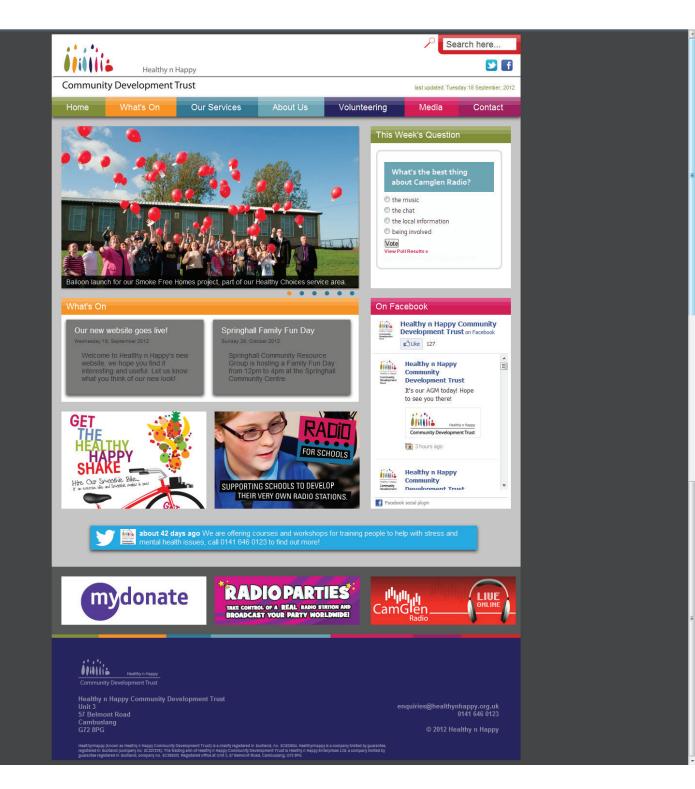

Who is it for?

If you are a parent living in the area of Cambuslang or Rutherglen with a baby or toddler under the age of two, you are welcome! We have two different cafes in Whitlawburn, one for younger babies (0-1 years) and one for older babies and toddlers (1-2 years). We also have another cafe in Burnhill for babies under one.

How to get involved

Our Wednesday cafe at the Whitlawburn Community Resource Centre (Mull Room) 10am to 12pm and our Thursday cafe at Burnhill Sports Centre from 1pm to 3pm are both for babies under one. Our Friday cafe from 1pm to 2pm in Whitlawburn Community Resource Centre is for babies and toddlers from one to two years old.

You don't need to phone up in advance, just turn up! We suggest a voluntary donation of £2 per week, to help cover the costs of the café, but this is optional.

We have a range of different activities and taster sessions available at the cafes including Rhyme Time, mental health awareness, money matters, and child development activities.

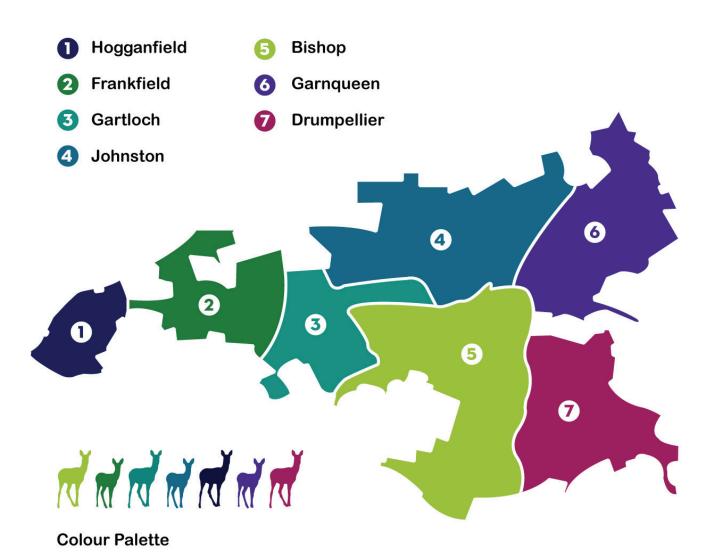

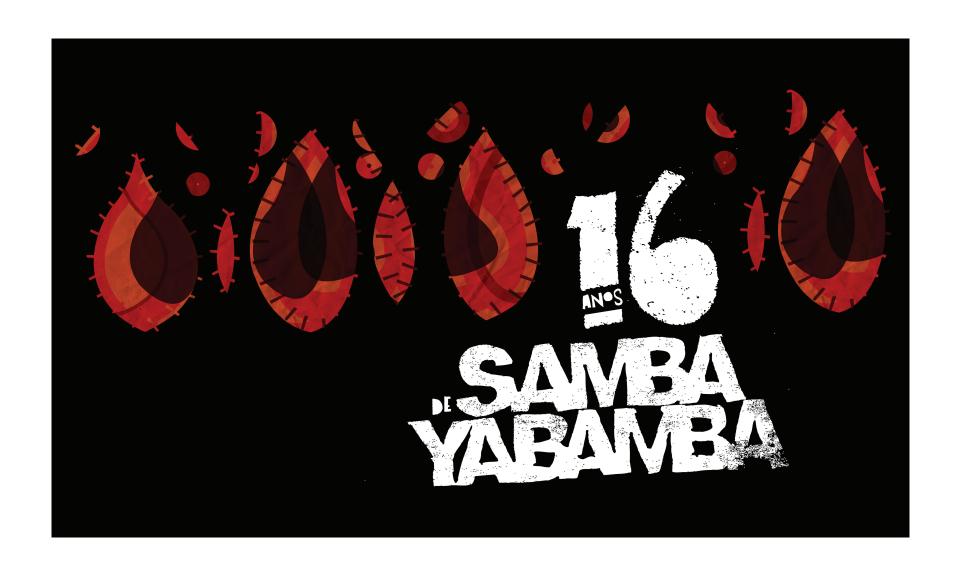
